Beltology (Glossary)

Mechanical Shrinkage:

Shrinkage of belt caused due to ingress of dirt and soil in the belts' fabric. Residues can cause serious shrinkage; this shrinkage can lead as a consequence to warping/curling, banana-effect and also to delamination of fabric.

Effects of mechanical shrinkage: Waves, curling, delamination, edge fraying, mistracking and increased belt tensile forces.
